Profile:

As a Graduate Chartered Engineer, a member of ICE, CMIOSH, PMI and Accredited Principal Designer and Principal Contractor with 40 years experience within the construction, aviation and education sectors, I've managed major projects for blue chip clients. Selected Achievements:

Leadership – I've lead on the updating of Health & Safety systems for Jericho Construction.

I directed the Developer and design and construction teams on behalf of Vine Trust to complete the new Goldmine Centre £2.7m, 2,000 m2, to maximise the available funds to satisfy changing requirements.

I've also lead teams of planning consultants, construction managers and designers on behalf of Ikea Properties leading on multiple projects ranging in value from £3m to £13m and 6 months to 2 years.

New Business – Using contacts within Walsall Council, I developed and project managed a new service to co-ordinate volunteers to assist with the monitoring of quality in Care Homes and improve residents' experience within Care Homes.

I was also part of the team bringing Walsall Studio School to the Goldmine Centre with special responsibility for Finance and Property matters.

As part of the expansion of Vine Trust into Ikea Cardiff, I was accountable for the TUPE process during the transfer of the existing shopping tools contract.

Identifying and introducing the benefits of working in the aviation industry to the company by promoting management capabilities to City Hopper Airports. Supervising and assisting the designers working in this new sector increased the company workload from just this new initiative by £45k per year. I managed the Planning Application and Design processes associated with the extended runway at Wolverhampton Airport.

Organisation – Having reviewed the existing construction management systems, I worked with the managers at Jericho Construction to amend and add systems as necessary to improve cost controls.

I monitored and engaged with the existing contractor for budget, quality, programme and safety issues on 2 projects at Woburn Place (400 beds) and Kirby Street (135 beds) for Unite Student Accommodation as the existing specification was changed post-contract to achieve Premium Upgrade as opposed to My Space specification.

Customer focussed – I've always been very motivated to make sure Customers are as happy as I can achieve within budget and time constraints. As part of this process, I've helped set up Management Systems to comply with ISO 9001 in three separate organisations.

Having organised an innovative solution to fit this £13m, large area store on to a small site, I then lead the planning consultants, design and construction teams to adapt the solution to meet revised Client and Planning Authority requirements. I then directed the new team on the construction of the new store for Ikea at Bristol.

Control – To overcome a funding defrayment issue with regards to time constraints, I identified a solution to use existing land and property as quasi expenditure of £1.8m to allow funds to be released to an escrow account to cover construction costs of the new building.

I directed a new team on a £20m, high profile, publicly funded road/rail transfer facility project for TDG at Grangemouth. Having overhauled our procedures to meet the funding authority requirements and trained / monitored the team accordingly, I then delivered the project in stages as a late requirement of the Client to suit their changed circumstances.

Scheduling / Co-ordination – Taking tender data for a £1.2m sheltered housing refurbishment project, I amended and produced a detailed MS Project Gantt chart and updated progress to allow managers to co-ordinate the works more effectively.

I directed the £6m installation of high level picking racking system within the live customer areas and an extension to the Ikea Nottingham store to house the new, innovative automatic silo storage racking and mechanical handling cranes and conveyors. Having
